## RALLY OVERVIEW

Have you always wanted to “give back” to the beautiful place in which we live and camp? Well, here’s your chance to help maintain and conserve one of Colorado’s newest state parks, Cheyenne Mountain State Park. In addition to the more typical rally activities, we have the opportunity to work with members of a trained trail crew to maintain and/or develop control of a trail. Should you choose to volunteer for the crew, a typical work session is four to six hours.

We have reserved all 13 sites in the Meadows Group Camp Loop. Sites are full hookup with 9 back ins and 4 pull throughs. One of the pull throughs is handicap accessible. The Camper Services Building offers showers, laundry, playground,



and activities room. There are hiking trails throughout the park with four trails that are dog-friendly.

We will be getting together for nightly Happy Hours where we will offer optional activities for the next day. Saturday morning has been set aside for trail work participation for those interested. A guided hike around the newly established archery range will follow for anyone interested in seeing this unique feature.

### **RALLY ACTIVITIES & SCHEDULE**

We will gather for Happy Hour at 5:30 each afternoon. Plan to bring chairs, utensils, plates, beverage of choice, and an appetizer to share. At that time, we will provide information on optional daytime activities which you can do on your own or with others, as well as a signup sheet for those who plan to do trail work on Saturday.

### **RALLY MENU**

A variety of snacks will be provided for Thursday evening's game night. We will also provide a dinner of pizza, salad and dessert on Saturday night. Please bring chairs, plates, utensils and beverage of choice to this meal. Dinners on Thursday and Friday nights are on your own, giving you options to pair up for dinner or go out to eat. Charcoal grills are available on site.

## RALLY FEE AND CAMP SITE RATES

CAC has prepaid the full group camping reservation fee for all 13 sites as required by the state park system. Your registration fee includes 3 nights of camping and a rally fee for food provided (see below). There is an entrance fee of \$7.00 daily if you do not have a Colorado State Parks pass.

The cost of registration for the three-night rally in Cheyenne Mountain State Park is \$100.00 per trailer.

**CAC has reserved and paid for all 13 sites, so please do not contact the campground to reserve a site. You will be unable to do so.)**

The rally fee is \$12.00 for each adult and child over 10, \$6.00 for children 5 – 10.

A full refund will be given for cancellation only if we are able to fill your reserved site for the three nights with someone on the waitlist. If there is no waitlist, or we are unable to fill your site prior to the rally, no refund will be given as all costs have incurred.

Check-in time on Thursday is at 1:00 PM. Check-out on Sunday is by 12:00 PM.

We are limited to 13 sites so please send in your registration form early. Once our limited spaces are filled, we will start a waitlist to backfill last minute cancelations.
